Question 4. Which mentors in each of our 3 themes are you going to engage in the course of your project? Describe in detail how you will integrate the three themes in your research? (Half a page max)

TWO PAGES (EXCLUDING FIGURES, TABLES)

Research Proposal – (Two-page Limit excluding references. Use headings as described)

1. Background and Significance (~10 lines)
2. Specific Aims (Be brief)
3. Preliminary Data
4. Research Plan (include pitfalls and alternatives, budget/funding source for the research, and a graphical timeline/table with project deliverables with expected outcome eg presentation at a meeting, manuscript) (1.5 page max)
5. Training Plan (Include your intended coursework in addition to required courses and briefly emphasize how this will help you in your proposed research)
